- a. ...Is to provide:
 - i. Assistance in academic planning
 - ii. College and personal counseling
 - iii. Study & organization strategies
 - iv. Direction for resume builders
 - v. Letters of recommendation
 - vi. Help in setting goals
- b. Counselor do's and don'ts
 - i. Don't:
 - 1. Do the work for you
 - 2. Make schedule changes for teacher preferences, athletic schedules, or for easier classes during certain periods
 - 3. Put you in classes for which you don't qualify
 - ii. Do:
 - 1. Help guide you and provide tools for success
 - 2. Help you problem solve through challenging situations
 - 3. Provide you with the necessary information to plan ahead

II. School logistics

- a. School hours and Bell Schedule:
 - i. JSerra is on a modified block schedule
 - ii. Check the JSerra Calendar Daily
 - iii. Lunch
 - 1. Lunch A underclass lunch
 - 2. Lunch B upperclass lunch
 - 3. For schedules 1, 3A, 3B, 4, and 5, the 5th period determines the lunch
 - 4. For schedule 2, the 4th period determines the lunch
 - 5. The level of the course determines the lunch, not the student's grade. (i.e. if a student is in Chemistry or Algebra 2 during 5th period, he/she will have 2nd lunch)
- b. Room numbers
 - i. $1223 = Building 1, 2^{nd} floor, Room #23$
- c. Honors vs. AP
 - i. Honors = high school level course that is accelerated
 - ii. AP = college level course, potential to earn college credit
 - iii. Must meet all pre-requisites to place into these courses



- iv. Students taking AP and honors courses will also have one point weighted credit in their GPA for every AP or Honors course taken for grades of "C" or better. AP/Honor teachers can require a student to level down if it is deemed a student cannot be successful. (Refer to Parent/Student Handbook for more information).
- d. Grading and GPA
 - i. 2 quarters per semester, 1 final per semester, and 2 semesters per year
 - ii. Grades reset at each quarter
 - iii. Only semester grades appear on transcript and compute into cumulative GPA
 - iv. Grading at semester
 - 1. Quarters = 40% of semester grade
 - 2. Finals = 20% of semester grade
 - v. All classes in which a student received a "D" or an "F" at the semester(s) must be remediated during summer school at JSerra.
- e. Schedule change policy
 - i. No elective changes including Arts, PE, and College Prep Electives
 - ii. Schedule changes will be made only to correct scheduling errors, make level changes, (up or down due to academic rigor), or resolve lunch conflicts
 - iii. Please be aware of the schedule change deadline for each semester which will be announced at the beginning of the semester.
 - iv. Must fill out schedule change forms found online or in Counseling Office
- f. Attendance policy
 - i. 12 or more absences can result in loss of credit
 - ii. You are allowed as many days as you are absent to make up work
 - iii. You must schedule any makeup tests with your teacher
- g. Counselor meetings
 - i. Formal meetings are once a year
 - ii. Sign up on counselor doors or email directly for an appointment
 - iii. Counseling Department hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the school year.
 - iv. Counseling Department summer hours are 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Counselors are available on a rotating basis during the summer.

JSerra Graduation Requirements

To graduate from JSerra Catholic High School, students must successfully complete a minimum of 270 credits. JSerra requirements meet or exceed university requirements. Successful completion of course work must include the following requirements with a semester grade of C or greater:

Theology 4 years 40 cr	redits*
English 4 years 40 cr	edits
Mathematics 3 years 30 cr	edits
Science 3 years 30 cr	edits
Social Science 3 years 30 cr	edits
World Language* 2 years 20 cr	edits
Arts 1 year 10 cro	edits
Health 1/2 year 5 cr	redits
Freshman Comm. 1/2 year 5 cr	redits*
Physical Education 2 years 20 cr	edits
Electives 40 cr	redits*

Credits required to graduate <u>270</u> credits**

All students must remediate any D's and/or F's in order to graduate from JSerra.

^{*} Freshman Communications is not required for transfer students.

^{*} Previous Theology credits will be waived for transfer students coming from public schools.

^{*}International Students are exempt from world language requirements. However, green card holders still need to complete all graduation requirements.

^{*}Electives can be met by taking courses over the minimum requirements (i.e. taking a fourth year of science can count towards elective credits).

^{**}A Christian service component (80 hours) is required for graduation.

Transfer students are required to do 10 hours per semester they attend JSerra.
